Scope and Content Note:

Collection documents the Employees' Retirement Fund (ERF), a defined benefit pension plan for City of Dallas non-uniformed employees, and the Dallas Police and Fire Pension System, a pension plan for uniformed employees of those departments. The funds provide retirement, disability, and survivor benefits to members and their beneficiaries.

The Dallas Police and Fire Pension System was created by the City of Dallas in 1916, and in 1933 was established under Article 6243a, *Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes*. The System is administered by a 12-member Board of Trustees, consisting of four City Councilmembers appointed by the City Council, and three active Police Officers, three active Firefighters, one retired Police Officer, and one retired Firefighter, all elected by the membership. The Mayor chaired the Board of Trustees until 1976, and a Councilmember Trustee chaired the Board until 1983. Since that time, the chair has been elected by the Trustees from among the membership of the Board.

The System is a single employer-defined benefit plan under Section 401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States. It provides retirement, survivor, and disability benefits to the uniformed public safety employees of the City of Dallas.

A Board of seven trustees governs the fund. ERF active members elect three trustees; three are appointed by Dallas City Council, and the City Auditor serves by virtue of position. Elections for the employee elected trustees are held annually. The elected trustees serve for two-year terms. The Board of Trustees appoints the Executive Director of the Fund.

The collection contains printed annual reports, employee benefits enrollment forms and materials, and ordinances.
