

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Justice has made funding available to the City of Dallas under the Community Oriented Policing Services Technology Program to enhance public safety; and

**WHEREAS**, grant funds will be used for the upgrade of hardware and software to improve efficiency and allow for easier data sharing with other agencies in the region.

**NOW, THEREFORE**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**Section 1.** That the City Manager be authorized to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice under the Community Oriented Policing Services Technology Program to enhance public safety by upgrading hardware and software in an amount not to exceed \$93,530.00.

**Section 2.** That the City Manager be authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$93,530.00 in Fund F223, Department CMO, Unit 3288, Object Code 3099.

**Section 3.** That the City Controller be authorized to deposit grant funds in Fund F223, Department CMO, Unit 3288, Revenue Source 6506, in an amount not to exceed \$93,530.00.

**Section 4.** That the City Controller be authorized to disburse funds from Fund F223, Department CMO, Unit 3288, Object Code 3099, in an amount not to exceed \$93,530.00.

**Section 5.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
