WHEREAS, Halff Associates, Inc. was selected to create an integrated floodplain database, analyzing flood control alternatives for site specific locations, provide public outreach in flood prone areas, staff training, floodplain reviews and coordination with various entities regarding drainage, floodplain and permiting activities, in an amount not to exceed \$142,000.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Halff Associates, Inc. to create an integrated floodplain database, analyzing flood control alternatives for site specific locations, provide public outreach in flood prone areas, staff training, floodplain reviews and coordination with various entities regarding drainage, floodplain and permiting activities, in an amount not to exceed \$142,000.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract after it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.
