WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, has made funds available for forensic equipment, training and personnel for the National Integrated Ballistics Information Network site for the 2009-10 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program grant will provide funds in the amount of \$125,000; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to apply for and accept such funding;

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program grant, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000 (subject to future appropriations) from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs.

Section 2. That in the event that the grant is awarded, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

Section 3. That in the event that the grant is awarded, the City of Dallas assures that funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full in the event of loss or misuse of the U.S. Department of Justice Grant Funds.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
