WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and the Denton County Criminal District Attorney desire to enter into a Local Agreement regarding disposition of \$27,470 Current Money of the United States forfeited contraband seized under Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, entitled "Forfeiture of Contraband" provides for the forfeiture to the State of Texas of property found to be "contraband" as defined therein; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure authorizes "local agreements" between the attorney representing the State and law enforcement agencies to effect the disposition of forfeited contraband; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney of Denton County, Texas, represents the State of Texas in The State of Texas v. \$27,470 Current Money of the United States, Cause No. 2009-50077-367, regarding forfeiture of \$27,470 Current Money of the United States seized pursuant to Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure;

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to enter into a Local Agreement with the Denton County Criminal District Attorney for the disposition of contraband seized and forfeited under Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure for the mutual considerations stated herein:

- a. The City of Dallas will receive two-thirds (66.66%) and the Denton County Criminal District Attorney one-third (33.33%) of the money seized and forfeited.
- b. The City of Dallas shall pay for all court costs and litigation expenses related to the forfeiture proceeding in the case of The State of Texas v. \$27,470 Current Money of the United States, Cause No. 2009-50077-367.
- c. The term of this Local Agreement shall be for the case of The State of Texas v. \$27,470 Current Money of the United States, Cause No. 2009-50077-367.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
