**WHEREAS**, UT Southwestern Medical Center is constructing a new biomedical research facility near the intersection of Forest Park Road and Inwood Road; and,

**WHEREAS**, UT Southwestern Medical Center is also constructing a driveway to connect this research facility to the intersection of Forest Park Road and Inwood Road; and,

**WHEREAS**, the existing traffic signal hardware at Forest Park and Inwood Road needs to be adjusted to accommodate the new driveway; and,

**WHEREAS**, UT Southwestern Medical Center has agreed to compensate the City of Dallas for material and labor costs related to the adjustment of the traffic signal hardware at the intersection of Forest Park Road and Inwood Road.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**Section 1.** That the City Manager is authorized to accept funds from UT Southwestern Medical Center for the adjustment of traffic signal hardware at the intersection of Forest Park Road and Inwood Road in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

**Section 2.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Capital Projects Reimbursement Fund 0556, Dept. PBW, Unit P554, Obj. 4820 in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

**Section 3.** That the City Controller is hereby authorized to deposit funds from UT Southwestern Medical Center pertaining to this project in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 in the Capital Projects Reimbursement Fund 0556, Dept. PBW, Unit P554, Revenue Source 8492.


**Section 4.** That the City Controller is hereby authorized to disburse funds received from UT Southwestern Medical Center in the amount of \$25,000 from Fund 0556, Dept. PBW, Unit P554, Act. Thrg, Obj. 4820, Program TPP55409 for services related to the signal installation.

**Section 5.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas and it is accordingly so resolved.
