WHEREAS, Standard Aero Limited was authorized to perform the inspections, testing and repairs on February 7, 2009, to helicopter engine N1510L that was in need of a required 1,750 flight hour heavy maintenance inspection, at the Dallas Police Department Helicopter Unit, 5775 Chuck Taylor Drive, and:

WHEREAS, while in the process of inspecting the compressor case halves and engine turbine, all defects found were repaired during the scope of this work, and;

WHEREAS, the City now desires ratification by the City Council of this expenditure under the Charter of the City of Dallas.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager hereby authorizes the tear-down repair to police helicopter engine N1510L located at the Dallas Police Helicopter Unit at 5775 Chuck Taylor Drive is hereby ratified as an emergency expenditure.
