WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Ordinance, Chapter 20A of the Dallas City Code, was amended on November 7, 1990 and September 25, 1991 for the purpose of obtaining certification from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) that the City of Dallas is a fair housing agency operating substantially equivalent to HUD; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 1992, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development granted the City of Dallas interim certification as a substantially equivalent fair housing agency; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 1995, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development granted the City of Dallas final certification as a substantially equivalent fair housing agency; and

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2010, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development granted the City Fair Housing Assistance Program Comprehensive Funding Approach funds for Fiscal Year 2010-11 in the amount of \$224,324; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to accept the Fair Housing Assistance Comprehensive Funding Approach Award (FHAP) funds for FY 2010-11 in the amount of \$224,324 and to execute any and all documents related to the award with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in the amount of \$224,324 in Fund F292, Department MGT, Unit 3345, and take actions to implement the 2010-11 FHAP Award.

Section 3. That the City Controller be authorized to receive and deposit these funds in the amount of \$224,324, in Fund F292, Department MGT, Revenue Source 6506, Unit 3345.

Section 4. That the City Controller be authorized to disburse funds from Fund F292, Department MGT, Unit 3345, in an amount not to exceed \$224,324 in accordance with the Cooperative Agreement.

Section 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
