WHEREAS, State law requires that emergency medical technicians receive training in basic life science courses; and

WHEREAS, The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas, in cooperation with The Dallas County Community College District, provides a training system which conducts basic life science courses for the training of emergency medical technicians; and

WHEREAS, it is mandatory and in the best interest of the community that such courses continue to be made available to the City to assist in the training, retraining and evaluation of the City of Dallas emergency medical technician personnel;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$54,320 for tuition payments, registration fees, books, and parking expenses to the Dallas County Community College District and the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas for emergency medical service training of Dallas Fire-Rescue Department personnel conducted from October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, subject to annual appropriations in FY 2010-2011, such funds are to be disbursed on an as-needed, per class basis.

Section 2. That the City Controller be and is hereby authorized to pay for these services from Fund 0001, DEPT DFD, UNIT 2050, OBJ 3070, Encumbrance CT DFD20500688-3, Vendor #004581 in the amount of \$44,800, and from Fund 0001, DEPT DFD, UNIT 2050, OBJ 3070, Encumbrance CT DFD20500689-3, Vendor #904272 in the amount of \$9,520.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas and it is accordingly so resolved.
