WHEREAS, on May 5, 2003, Dallas voters approved the use of General Obligation Bonds to acquire property for future City facilities; and

WHEREAS, Jose Contreras and Efren Contreras will be displaced as a direct result of this property acquisition and will vacate the property; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39A of the Revised Code of Civil and Criminal Ordinances of the City of Dallas provides moving expense and rental assistance payments for individuals displaced by City of Dallas property acquisition activities; and

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2007, the City Council approved Resolution No. 07-1151 authorizing the acquisition of 2407 Chrysler Drive located in the Cadillac Heights neighborhood, to be used in conjunction with the construction of future City facilities; and

Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Jose Contreras and Efren Contreras will be displaced in conjunction with future City facilities and are entitled to moving expense and rental assistance payments pursuant to Chapter 39A of the Revised Code of Civil and Criminal Ordinances of the City of Dallas.

SECTION 2. That Jose Contreras and Efren Contreras are eligible to receive a moving expense payment in an amount up to \$1,300 and a rental assistance payment in an amount up to \$14,700.

SECTION 3. That the City Controller is authorized to draw warrants in favor of Jose Contreras and Efren Contreras in an amount not to exceed \$16,000 for moving expense and rental assistance payments.

These warrants are to be paid as follows:
