Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to execute a service contract with Page, Wolfberg & Wirth, LLC (VS0000061566) for independent review of ambulance billing and health care programs as required in the Integrity Agreement with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for a term of three years, with two one-year extension options, in an amount not to exceed \$516,564.00, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.
