**WHEREAS**, on January 11, 2006, City Council authorized a twelve-month technical service support agreement for the maintenance of seventy-four LifePak 12 cardiac defibrillator/electrocardiogram monitors and fifty battery support systems by Resolution No. 06-0124; and,

**WHEREAS**, on April 11, 2007, City Council authorized a thirty-six-month service contract for the maintenance of cardiac defibrillator/electrocardiogram monitors and support systems by Resolution No. 07-1137; and,

**WHEREAS**, on March 10, 2010, City Council authorized a five-year master agreement for the purchase of cardiac monitor/external defibrillators, support systems and supplies and a five-year service contract for the maintenance of cardiac defibrillator/electrocardiogram monitors and support systems by Resolution No. 10-0676:

## NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS

**Section 1.** That following approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to increase the service contract with Physio-Control, Inc. (038759) through The National Association of State Procurement Officials for four years for the maintenance of 61 LIFEPAK® Model 1000 units, in an amount not to exceed \$94,778.75, increasing the service contract amount from \$379,115 to \$473,893.75.

**Section 2**. That the City Controller is authorized to disburse funds from the following appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$94,778.75 (subject to annual appropriations):
