**Alternate No. 6 - provides for a building plaque.


**Alternate No. 7 - provides for resurfacing and restriping parking lot.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that acceptance of the final and best offer from Primestar Construction Corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,383,740 is the best value for the City of Dallas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PARK AND RECREATION BOARD AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:



SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Primestar Construction Corporation for renovation and an addition to include a new multi-purpose room, restrooms and a fitness room at Cummings Recreation Center, in an amount not to exceed \$1,383,740.

SECTION 2. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute a contract with Primestar Construction Corporation, after approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office.

SECTION 3. That the City Controller is hereby authorized to pay the amount of \$1,383,740 to Primestar Construction Corporation, as follows:
