WHEREAS, Zebra Mussels are an invasive species that can have a major economic impact on reservoirs, water supply intakes and infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, Zebra Mussels have migrated to Texas and into the Trinity River basin, including Lake Ray Hubbard; and,

WHEREAS, Lake Ray Hubbard is a primary drinking water resource for Dallas and its customer cities; and,

WHEREAS, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department has developed a zebra mussel public education campaign targeted for North Texas; **Now Therefore,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter in to a Memorandum of Understanding with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department to provide funding for the implementation of the Zebra Mussel public education campaign targeted for North Texas.

Section 2. That the City Controller be authorized to pay the sum of \$25,000 from the Water Utilities Current Fund as follows:
