WHEREAS, the City of Dallas has participated with the United States Geological Survey (USGS) in a Zebra Mussel monitoring program; and,

WHEREAS, the USGS, has submitted a contract amendment to increase the monitoring program for the period October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, with the cost of the City of Dallas' share of the amended monitoring program increasing by \$40,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, a joint funding agreement is the most cost-effective method for the City of Dallas to obtain the required data; **Now, Therefore**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That a contract for a surface water monitoring program between the USGS and the City of Dallas is hereby approved, and that the City Manager be authorized to sign the contract for the City of Dallas.

Section 2. That the City Controller is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$40,000 from the Water Utilities Current Fund as follows:
