WHEREAS, on December 10, 2008, City Council authorized a nine-month master agreement for National Sanitation Foundation (NSF) 60 Dipotassium Orthophosphate to be used by Water Utilities by Resolution No. 08-3295; and,

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2010, City Council authorized a one-year master agreement for dipotassium orthophosphate (chemical for corrosion control) to be used by Water Utilities by Resolution No. 10-0674; and,

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2011, City Council authorized a one-year master agreement for dipotassium orthophosphate (chemical for corrosion control) to be used by Water Utilities by Resolution No. 11-0624;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That a master agreement for the purchase of dipotassium orthophosphate to be used by Water Utilities is authorized with Carus Corporation (VS0000052233) for a term of three years in an amount not to exceed \$6,359,100.00.

Section 2. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for dipotassium orthophosphate to be used by Water Utilities. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases of dipotassium orthophosphate to be used by Water Utilities under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is authorized to execute the contract upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. That the City Controller is authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$6,359,100.00.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas and it is accordingly so resolved.
