WHEREAS, in the 2006 Bond Program, the citizens of Dallas approved funding for the design and construction of the new Facilities Maintenance Building to be located at the Southeast Service Center on Municipal Street; and,

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of a selection process conducted by city staff, Huitt-Zollars, Inc. was chosen as the most qualified firm to provide professional services for this project; and,

WHEREAS, it is now desirable to enter into a professional services contract with Huitt-Zollars, Inc. to provide architectural and engineering services for design and construction administration for the Facilities Maintenance Building to be located at the Southeast Service Center at 2800 Municipal Street in an amount not to exceed \$1,454,620.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a professional services contract with Huitt-Zollars, Inc. to provide architectural and engineering services for design and construction administration for the Facilities Maintenance Building to be located at the Southeast Service Center at 2800 Municipal Street in an amount not to exceed \$1,454,620, after it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.
