WHEREAS, severe erosion has occurred along the banks downstream of the Fair Oaks Crossing Bridge over Jackson Branch Tributary which will eventually compromise the structural integrity of the bridge; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to correct the erosion problems; and,

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2010, Resolution No. 10-0478 authorized a professional services contract with TranSystems Corporation for the design of bridge and erosion control improvements for Fair Oaks Crossing Bridge over Jackson Branch Tributary in the amount of \$52,225.00; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received on January 12, 2012, for construction of bridge and erosion control Improvements for Fair Oaks Crossing Bridge over Jackson Branch Tributary as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Texas Standard Construction, Ltd. for the construction of bridge and erosion control improvements for Fair Oaks Crossing Bridge over Jackson Branch Tributary in an amount not to exceed \$270,817.00, this being the lowest responsive bid received as indicated by the tabulation of bids, after it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The City Controller is hereby authorized to disburse funds in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract from:

ERCT Obj. 4510, Program # PBSWM002, CT# PBWSWM002F1 Vendor # 339573, in an amount not to exceed \$270,817.00 **Section 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas and it is accordingly so resolved.
