

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2012, Police staff briefed and obtained the approval of the Automated Red Light Commission to establish a fund to support the charitable or educational purposes of the Dallas SafeLight Program; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2012 the Public Safety Committee was briefed on the Dallas Foundation agreement and recommended approval; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Dallas Foundation agreement shall be to support the charitable or educational purposes of the SafeLight program including promotions, advertisement, promotional items, and training and education for the community; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Foundation will hold and distribute donations from the public for the benefit of the SafeLight Program and pay expenses for the campaign from donations, send thank you letters and annually report donations to the IRS.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Dallas Foundation for the purpose of receiving public donations and paying expenses for the Dallas SafeLight program's educational and awareness campaign.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
