WHEREAS, on August 12, 2009, Resolution No. 09-1949 authorized a professional services contract with GSWW, a division of Burgess & Niple, Inc. for the flood study of Northwest Highway (West) at Tulane Boulevard; and,

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2011, Administrative Action No. 10-2900 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the contract with GSWW, a division of Burgess & Niple, Inc. for hydraulic modeling of a diversion system, in an amount not to exceed \$24,500, from \$151,380 to \$175,880.

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2011, Resolution No. 11-0962 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the contract with GSWW, a division of Burgess & Niple, Inc., for the engineering design of floodgates and erosion control improvements, in an amount not to exceed \$75,750, increasing the contract from \$175,880.00 to \$251,630; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received on May 10, 2012, for the construction of erosion control improvements for 3908 and 3918 Vinecrest Drive and 3809 Sleepy Lane (Erosion Control Group 06-808), as follows:

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Austin Filter Systems, Inc. for erosion control improvements at 3908 and 3918 Vinecrest Drive and 3809 Sleepy Lane (Erosion Control Group 06-808) in an amount not to exceed \$276,708.50, this being the lowest responsive bid as indicated by the tabulation of bids.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract after it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. That the City Controller is hereby authorized to disburse funds in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contracts from:
