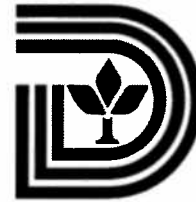

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dallas has identified the need to evaluate aging roofs and HVAC equipment at the Water Utilities Department's 230 facilities and prepare a condition assessment report with recommendations for repairs, modifications, or replacements; and,

**WHEREAS**, architectural and engineering services are required for a condition assessment to establish a yearly maintenance program, and associated designs of roof and HVAC systems deemed critical; and,

**WHEREAS**, the bid submitted by Chamberlin Dallas, LLC, 2346 Glenda Lane, Dallas, Texas 75229, in the amount of \$1,572,266.00, is the lowest and best of all bids received; **Now, Therefore**,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**Section 1.** That the bid submitted by Chamberlin Dallas, LLC in the amount of \$1,572,266.00 for doing the work covered by the plans, specifications, and contract documents, Contract No. 12-081, be accepted.

**Section 2.** That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chamberlin Dallas, LLC, for the restoration of the exterior envelope of the White Rock Pump Station and security improvements at the White Rock Pump Station and the Hoyle Avenue pumping facility, after having approval of the contract documents by the City Attorney.

**Section 3.** That the City Controller be and is hereby authorized to pay the amount of \$1,572,266.00 from the Water Construction Fund as follows:
