WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) through the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) has indicated that the following Dallas Love Field Projects: Airfield Signage, Taxiway D2, Taxiway B5 & D, and the Master Plan Update are eligible for federal funding from the Federal Aviation Administration; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable to apply for and accept reimbursement funds from the FAA for the eligible costs of each project.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept reimbursement funds from the FAA in the amount of \$3,435,277 of the estimated costs, and to apply for and accept future increases in the project cost when approved by both the City and the FAA.

Section 2. That upon acceptance of FAA reimbursement funds, the City Controller is authorized to receive and deposit funds in the amount of \$745,800 for Airfield Signage to be deposited in the Aviation Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Fund F367; Dept. AVI; Unit 7713; Revenue Source 9907.

Section 3. That upon acceptance of FAA reimbursement funds, the City Controller is authorized to receive and deposit funds in the amount of \$708,833 for Taxiway D2 to be deposited in the Aviation Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Fund F367; Dept. AVI; Unit 7714; Revenue Source 9907.

Section 4. That upon acceptance of FAA reimbursement funds, the City Controller is authorized to receive and deposit funds in the amount of \$661,467 for Taxiway B5 & D to be deposited in the Aviation Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Fund F367; Dept. AVI; Unit 7715; Revenue Source 9907.

Section 5. That upon acceptance of FAA reimbursement funds, the City Controller is authorized to receive and deposit funds in the amount of \$1,319,177 for the Master Plan Update to be deposited in the Aviation Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Fund F367; Dept. AVI; Unit 7716; Revenue Source 9907.

Section 6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
