

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2007, City Council authorized a twelve-month master agreement for liquid ferric sulfate for the City's three water purification treatment plants by Resolution No. 07-3687; and,

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2009, City Council authorized a twenty-four month master agreement for liquid ferric sulfate for the City's three water purification treatment plants by Resolution No. 09-0452; and,

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2011, City Council authorized an increase in the master agreement for liquid ferric sulfate for the City's water purification treatment plants by Resolution No. 11-3220;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That a master agreement for the purchase of ferric sulfates to be used in the water purification process is authorized with General Chemical Performance Products, LLC (053277) for a term of two years in an amount not to exceed \$13,244,000.00.

Section 2. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for ferric sulfates to be used in the water purification process. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases of ferric sulfates to be used in the water purification process under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is authorized to execute the contract upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. That the City Controller is authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$13,244,000.00.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
