WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile and Delinquency Prevention has made supplemental grant funds available to aid missing and exploited children during the 2012-2013 fiscal year;

WHEREAS, such funding was awarded to the City of Dallas on September 28, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the Internet Crimes Against Children Continuation Grant, 2010-MC-CX-K037, CFDA #16.543 in an amount not to exceed \$427,686 increasing the award from \$824,027 to \$1,251,713 the period April 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013 and execute the grant agreement.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase the appropriation in the Internet Crimes Against Children Continuation Grant fund in the amount of \$427,686 from \$824,027 to \$1,251,713, Fund F411, Department DPD, Unit 2728, in accordance with Schedule A.

Section 3. That the City Controller is hereby authorized to deposit supplement grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$427,686 in Fund F411, Department DPD, Unit 2728, Revenue Source 6506.

Section 4. That the City Manager will provide no funding for cash match for Internet Crimes Against Children Continuation Grant.

Section 5. That the City Manager will provide no funding for In-Kind contributions for the Internet Crimes Against Children Continuation Grant.

Section 6. That the City Controller is hereby authorized to disburse grant funds from Fund F411, Department DPD, Unit 2728, a supplemental amount not to exceed \$427,686, according to Schedule A.

Section 7. In the event of loss or misuse of funds, the City of Dallas will return all funds to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile and Delinquency Prevention in full.

Section 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
