WHEREAS, the City of Dallas is owner of certain real property conveyed to it by and described in instrument recorded at Volume 80060, Page 1286, Deed Records of Dallas County, Texas, (the "Abutting Property") which is or will be adjacent to and abutting public right-of-way to be developed by the Texas Department of Transportation, a State of Texas Agency, ("TxDOT") as Interstate Highway 30 (the "Horseshoe Project"); and

WHEREAS, TxDOT has determined that it is necessary or convenient to restrict abutter rights of access along a 107 linear foot length of the boundary line of the Abutting Property, said length being described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes (the "Controlled Access Line"); and

WHEREAS, TxDOT has requested from the City of Dallas a Release and Relinquishment of Access Right to Highway Facility as to the Abutting Property and the Controlled Access Line in conjunction with the Horseshoe Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to accommodate TxDOT's request and facilitate the Horseshoe Project; Now,Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That upon receipt of ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 ( $\$ 1,000.00$ ) DOLLARS from the State of Texas, the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute and deliver a Release and Relinquishment of Access Rights to Highway Facility, to be attested by the City Secretary upon approval as to form by the City Attorney as to the Controlled Access Line.

SECTION 2. That the proceeds shall be deposited into the General Capital Reserve Fund 0625, Department BMS, Unit 7263, Revenue Source 8118.

SECTION 3. That the procedures required by the Dallas City Code concerning the sale of interests in real property that are not required by state law are waived with respect to this transaction.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as provided by the Charter of the City of Dallas and it is accordingly so resolved.
