

WHEREAS, the City applied for reimbursement grant funding under State of Texas Comptroller's State Energy Program, managed by the State Energy Conservation Office (SECO) Alternative Fuel Vehicle grant program in the amount of \$50,000.00.

WHEREAS, this project includes the purchase of ten (10) alternative vehicles; and,

NOW, THEREFORE;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the grant agreement with the State of Texas Energy Comptroller's Office.

Section 2. That the City Controller is authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in Fund S258, Department EBS, Unit 1501, Revenue Source 6508, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00.

Section 3. That the City Manager is authorized to establish appropriations for the Alternative Fuel Vehicle Grant in Fund S258, Department EBS, Unit 1501 and Object Code 3899 in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 as set forth in the agreement with the State Energy Conservation Office.

Section 4. That the City Controller is authorized to disburse grant funds from Fund S258, Department EBS, Unit 1501, Object Code 3899, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00.

Section 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is so accordingly so resolved.
