

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2012, City Council authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to exercise the first renewal option to extend the term of the service contract, with a minimum annual guarantee, for the collection of delinquent fines and fees for City ordinance, traffic and state law violations, excluding parking violations, for the period August 1, 2012 through July 31, 2013 by Resolution No. 12-1618;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That following approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to exercise the second renewal option to extend the term of the service contract with Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP (501164), with a minimum annual guarantee, for the collection of delinquent fines and fees for City ordinance, traffic and state law violations, excluding parking violations, for the period August 1, 2013 through July 31, 2014 in an estimated revenue amount \$5,800,000.00.

Section 2. That the City Controller is hereby authorized to deposit all revenues received from Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP into Fund 0614, Dept. CTS, Unit 1054 and appropriate revenue source codes; and is authorized to transfer on a monthly basis revenue from special collection, Fund 0614, Dept. CTS, Unit 1054, less the commission costs to the collection agency, to the General Fund 0001, Dept. CTS, Unit 1057, in the appropriate revenue source codes.

Section 3. That the City Controller is hereby authorized to disburse funds to Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP according to the terms of the contract.

Section 4. That the resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
