

**WHEREAS**, a request for bid process is not cost beneficial to the City as determined by the City Manager; and,

**WHEREAS**, a specific and unique circumstance warrants preference to Culinaire International, Inc., whose stated mission is to benefit a specific municipal purpose; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dallas has, as one of its purposes, the establishment, maintenance, promotion and operation of recreational and cultural facilities for the benefit of the public; and,

**WHEREAS**, on April 27, 2005, City Council authorized a sixty-month service contract for food and beverage service with Culinaire International, Inc. by Resolution No. 05-1373; and,

**WHEREAS**, on November 10, 2010, City Council authorized a thirty-one month extension to the service contract for food and beverage service with Culinaire International, Inc. by Resolution No. 10-2865;

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**Section 1.** That following approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an extension to the concession contract with Culinaire International, Inc. (500344) for the food and beverage services at the Morton H. Meyerson Symphony Center for a term of twenty-four (24) months for the period August 1, 2013 through July 31, 2015, for an estimated revenue amount of \$735,000.

**Section 2.** That the City Controller is authorized to deposit all revenues received from Culinaire International, Inc. as follows:

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**Section 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
