

WHEREAS, bids were received on April 24, 2014, for the construction of utilities, roadway and streetscape improvements for the Colorado Boulevard Extension Project as follows:

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with North Texas Contracting, Inc. for construction of utilities, roadway and streetscape improvements for the Colorado Boulevard Extension Project in an amount not to exceed \$3,713,015.70, this being the lowest responsible bid received as indicated by the tabulation of bids, after it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.
