

WHEREAS, El Centro College, (hereafter referred to as “the COLLEGE”) of Dallas County Community College District, a Texas political subdivision of higher education, offers an Associate in Applied Sciences degree in Fire Protection Technology; and

WHEREAS, students pursuing the degree at the COLLEGE, and who have completed 12 semester credit hours of Fire Protection Technology prerequisite classes are eligible to participate in an internship and cooperative educational Program to complete direct practical experience to complement the academic experience; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas, a Texas municipal corporation through its Fire-Rescue Department (DFR), operates comprehensive fire and rescue services that encompass: Fire Operations and Administration, Special Operations, Fire Technology and Communications, Fire Prevention, Education, Inspection and Investigation, and Special Operations, (all hereafter referred to as “SERVICES”), that can successfully complement students’ academic studies; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted and in compliance with the provisions under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791, Texas Government Code Annotated, the Parties wish to enter into this agreement for the purpose of providing education internships for the eligible students.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement or a College Internship Program with Dallas County Community College District on behalf of the El Centro College, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
