

**WHEREAS**, the Texas State University System has made the Texas School Safety Center 2015/2016 Tobacco Enforcement Program funds available for the purpose of reducing youth access to tobacco products, and to ensure compliance with the Health and Safety Code, Chapter 161 for the period September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, such funding was awarded to the City of Dallas on July 15, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**Section 1.** That the City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to apply for and accept the Texas School Safety Center 2015/2016 Tobacco Enforcement Program funds in the amount of \$65,025 from the Texas State University System-San Marcos for the period September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016 and execute the grant agreement and other documents required by the grant.

**Section 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in Fund S281, Department DPD, Unit 1787, Revenue Source 6516, in an amount not to exceed \$65,025.

**Section 3.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in the amount of \$65,025, in Fund S281, Department DPD, Unit 1787, Object Code 3099.

**Section 4.** That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to disburse funds from Fund S281, Department DPD, Unit 1787, Object Code 3099, in an amount not to exceed \$65,025.


**Section 5.** That in the event of the loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return all funds to the Texas School Safety Center, in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

**Section 6.** That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final granting agency monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

**Section 7.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
