ORDINANCE NO. 29851

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 27782, passed by the Dallas City Council on January 13, 2010, which amended the zoning ordinances of the City of Dallas, and granted Specific Use Permit No. 1791 for an attached projecting non-premise district activity videoboard sign; amending the property description in Section 1 of that ordinance; amending the conditions in Section 2 of that ordinance; providing a penalty not to exceed \$2,000; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the city plan commission and the city council, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, the state law, and the ordinances of the City of Dallas, have given the required notices and have held the required public hearings regarding this amendment to Specific Use Permit No. 1791; and

WHEREAS, the city council finds that it is in the public interest to amend Specific Use Permit No. 1791; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the property description in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 27782 is amended to read as follows:

“BEING Lot 1[A] in City Block A/76; fronting approximately 150 feet on the south line of Elm Street; fronting approximately 200 feet on the east line of Akard Street; fronting approximately 150 feet on the north line of Main Street; and containing approximately 0.3443 acres.”

SECTION 2. That the conditions in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 27782 are amended to read as follows:

- “1. USE: The only use authorized by this specific use permit is an attached projecting non-premise district activity videoboard sign.
2. SITE PLAN: Use and development of the Property must comply with the attached site plan and elevation.
3. TIME LIMIT: This specific use permit expires [~~automatically terminates~~] on September 9, 2021 [~~January 13, 2016~~].
4. CLEARANCE: The attached projecting non-premise district activity videoboard sign must have a minimum clearance of 20 feet above the sidewalk as shown on the attached elevation.
5. DIMENSIONS:[-] The attached projecting non-premise district activity videoboard sign may not exceed a vertical length of 16 feet as shown on the attached site plan and elevation.
6. SIZE: The attached projecting non-premise district activity videoboard sign is limited to a maximum effective area of 144 square feet as shown on the attached site plan and elevation.
7. MAINTENANCE: The Property must be properly maintained in a state of good repair and neat appearance.
8. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: Use of the Property must comply with all federal and state laws and regulations, and with all ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City of Dallas. The sign must comply with Sections 51 A-7.909 and 51A 7.910 of the Dallas Development Code.”

SECTION 3. That a person who violates a provision of this ordinance, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.


SECTION 4. That the zoning ordinances of the City of Dallas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 5. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.

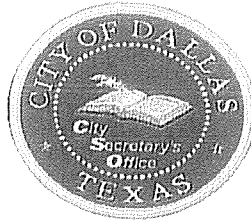
