ORDINANCE NO. 30566

An ordinance changing the zoning classification on the following property:

BEING part of Tract 4 within City Block 7609 located along the northwestern line of Interstate Highway 20 approximately 1,438 feet west of the western line of Lancaster Road; and containing approximately 9.474 acres,

from an R-7.5(A) Single Family District, a TH-2(A) Townhouse District, and an MF-2(A) Multifamily District to a CR Community Retail District; providing a penalty not to exceed \$2,000; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the city plan commission and the city council, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, the state law, and the ordinances of the City of Dallas, have given the required notices and have held the required public hearings regarding the rezoning of the property described in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the city council finds that it is in the public interest to change the zoning classification; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the zoning classification is changed from an R-7.5(A) Single Family District, a TH-2(A) Townhouse District, and an MF-2(A) Multifamily District to a CR Community Retail District on the property described in Exhibit A, which is attached to and made a part of this ordinance (“the Property”).

SECTION 2. That, pursuant to Section 51A-4.701 of Chapter 51A of the Dallas City Code, as amended, the property description in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be construed as including the area to the centerline of all adjacent streets and alleys.

SECTION 3. That the building official shall not issue a building permit or a certificate of occupancy for a use on the Property until there has been full compliance with the Dallas Development Code, the construction codes, and all other ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City of Dallas.

SECTION 4. That a person who violates a provision of this ordinance, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.

SECTION 5. That the zoning ordinances of the City of Dallas shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 6. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so ordained.

BEGINNING at a point for corner with the following coordinates: N – 6922517.795, E – 2496031.975 (referenced to NAD 83, Texas State Plane, North Central FIPS 4202, feet, on grid);

THENCE South 71 degrees 39 minutes 35 seconds West, an approximate distance of 855.07 feet to the Dallas city limit line;

THENCE North 04 degrees 39 minutes 35 seconds East, an approximate distance of 690.35 feet following the Dallas city limit line;

THENCE North 24 degrees 06 minutes 51 seconds East, a total distance of 63.93 feet;

THENCE along a curve to the left, having a central angle of 42 degrees 27 minutes 17 seconds, a radius of 600.00 feet, and a chord bearing and distance of South 87 degrees 06 minutes 47 seconds East, 434.48 feet, a total arc length of 444.58 feet;

THENCE North 71 degrees 39 minutes 35 seconds East, a total distance of 122.94 feet;

THENCE along a curve to the left, having a central angle of 06 degrees 44 minutes 33 seconds, a radius of 1945.00 feet, and a chord bearing and distance of South 17 degrees 59 minutes 17 seconds East, 228.76 feet, a total arc length of 228.89 feet;

THENCE South 21 degrees 21 minutes 33 seconds East, a total distance of 296.98 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing a total area of 412,693.80 square feet, or 9.474 acres of land, more or less.
