WHEREAS, on February 13, 2013, City Council authorized a one-year master agreement for anhydrous ammonia with Tanner Industries, Inc. by Resolution No. 13-0292; and

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2014, City Council authorized a three-year master agreement for anhydrous ammonia with DPC Industries, Inc. by Resolution No. 14-0501.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign a master agreement with Shrieve Chemical Company (VC17161) in the amount of \$1,717,200.00, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the purchase of anhydrous ammonia for Dallas Water Utilities for a term of three years in a total amount not to exceed \$1,717,200.00.

SECTION 2. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for anhydrous ammonia for Dallas Water Utilities. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases of anhydrous ammonia for Dallas Water Utilities under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,717,200.00 to Shrieve Chemical Company from Master Agreement Contract No. DWU-2018-00004459.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
