ORDINANCE NO. 3073 0

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 29848, passed by the Dallas City Council on September 9, 2015, which amended the zoning ordinances of the City of Dallas, and granted Specific Use Permit No. 2155 for a recycling buy-back center for the collection of household and industrial metals; amending the conditions in Section 2 of that ordinance; providing a penalty not to exceed \$2,000; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the city plan commission and the city council, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, the state law, and the ordinances of the City of Dallas, have given the required notices and have held the required public hearings regarding this amendment to Specific Use Permit No. 2155; and

WHEREAS, the city council finds that it is in the public interest to amend Specific Use Permit No. 2155; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS: SECTION 1. That the conditions in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 29848 are amended to read as follows:

- "1. <u>USE</u>: The only use authorized by this specific use permit is a recycling buy-back center for the collection of household and industrial metals.
- 2. <u>SITE PLAN</u>: Use and development of the Property must comply with the attached site plan.
- 3. <u>TIME LIMIT</u>: This specific use permit expires on <u>December 13, 2018</u> [September 9, 2017].
- 4. FLOOR AREA: The maximum floor area is 4,270 square feet.

- 5. <u>GATE</u>: Both double swing gates abutting <u>Lamar[Lamer]</u> Street and shown on the attached site plan must remain open during the hours of operation.
- 6. <u>HOURS OF OPERATION</u>: The recycling buy-back center for the collection of household and industrial metals may only operate between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Sunday.
- 7. <u>INGRESS/EGRESS</u>: Ingress and egress must be provided in the location<u>s shown</u> on the attached site plan. No other ingress or egress is permitted.
- 8. <u>LICENSE</u>: The Operator must maintain a secondary metal recycler's license in accordance with Chapter 40B of the Dallas City Code.
- 9. <u>MAINTENANCE</u>: The Property must be properly maintained in a state of good repair and neat appearance.
- 10. <u>GENERAL REQUIREMENTS</u>: Use of the Property must comply with all federal and state laws and regulations, and with all ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City of Dallas."

SECTION 2. That a person who violates a provision of this ordinance, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.

SECTION 3. That the zoning ordinances of the City of Dallas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 4. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.
