WHEREAS, according to the local Homeless Point in Time Count, overall homelessness increased by 9% in 2018 and 2019 and unsheltered homelessness increased by 24% and 16% in 2018 and 2019 respectively; and

WHEREAS, these increases in homelessness demonstrate the need to invest in subsidized housing solutions for homeless persons that promote self-sufficiency and housing stability; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2019, the Office of Procurement Services advertised a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals ("RFCSP") (#BPZ1905) to provide a Landlord Subsidized Leasing Program with financial assistance for eligible homeless persons and risk mitigation funds for landlords, to address challenges faced by persons experiencing homelessness as they navigate the rental market; and

WHEREAS, CitySquare submitted a proposal to provide a Landlord Subsidized Leasing Program, and is recommended for award.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a fifteen-month contract, with one twelve-month renewal option, with CitySquare, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to implement a Landlord Subsidized Leasing Program under Track 3 of the Homeless Solutions Strategy by providing move-in and rental assistance for eligible individuals and families in need of temporary assistance and risk mitigation funds to landlords that reserve units for eligible individuals and families experiencing homelessness for the period July 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$1,300,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,300,000.00 to CitySquare from General Fund, Fund, 0001, Department MGT, Unit 4311, Object 3070, Service Contract No. OHS-2019-00010380, Vendor VS0000000497.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
