**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will provide reimbursement to the City of Dallas for material and labor costs incurred for the reconstruction of two existing traffic signals at the intersections of State Spur (SS) 244 at Plano Road and SS 244 at Jupiter Road; and

**WHEREAS**, TxDOT will reimburse 100 percent of labor and material costs, in the amount of \$97,318.30; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dallas desires to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with TxDOT to receive cost reimbursement for material and labor costs incurred for traffic signal improvements at the intersections of SS 244 at Plano Road and SS 244 at Jupiter Road.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with TxDOT through a grant from the Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration (Agreement Nos. CSJ 0353-05-089 and CSJ 0353-05-090, CFDA No. 20.205) in the amount of \$97,318.30 to provide cost reimbursement for material and labor related to the reconstruction of two existing traffic signals at the intersections of SS 244 at Plano Road and SS 244 at Jupiter Road; and execute the Interlocal Agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in the amount of \$97,318.30 in the TxDOT 2019 Northwest Highway Signal Improvements Fund, Fund F8GH, Department TRN, Unit 89GH, Object 4820.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in the amount of \$97,318.30 in the TxDOT 2019 Northwest Highway Signal Improvements Fund, Fund F8GH, Department TRN, Unit 89GH, Revenue Code 6506.

**SECTION 4.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in the amount of \$97,318.30 from the TxDOT 2019 Northwest Highway Signal Improvements Fund, F8GH, Department TRN, Unit 89GH, Object 4820, Activity THRG, Major Program MJRTRN, Program TPF8GF19.

**SECTION 5.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse the granting agency any expenditures identified as ineligible and notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

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**SECTION 6.** That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final granting agency monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report

**SECTION 7.** That this contract is designated as Contract No. TRN-2020-00011895.

**SECTION 8.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
