WHEREAS, on September 9, 2015, City Council authorized a three-year master agreement for the purchase of veterinary drugs and supplies with Butler Animal Health Holding Company, LLC in the amount of \$2,101,317.40 and A-S Medication Solutions, LLC in the amount of \$295,200.00, by Resolution No. 15-1651; and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2018, City Council authorized a three-year master agreement for veterinary drugs and supplies consisting of medications, preventatives, vaccines, diagnostic tests, and supplies for the Department of Dallas Animal Services with Bayer Healthcare, LLC in the amount of \$2,254,265.75 or \$2,092,817.00 (Tie Bid – Line 3), MWI Veterinary Supply, Co. dba MWI Animal Health in the amount of \$997,808.00 or \$836,359.25 (Tie Bid – Line 3), and Harris Pharmaceutical, Inc. in the amount of \$40,000.08, in a total amount not to exceed \$3,130,625.08, by Resolution No. 18-0210.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That a master agreement for the purchase of veterinary medical supplies and medications for the Department of Dallas Animal Services is authorized with Midwest Veterinary Supply, Inc. (VS0000067504) in the estimated amount of \$2,947,732.97, MWI Veterinary Supply, Co. dba MWI Animal Health (VS0000035134) in the estimated amount of \$1,857,933.62, IDEXX Distribution, Inc. (333782) in the estimated amount of \$762,592.50, and Merck Animal Health (VS0000070669) in the estimated amount of \$658,053.36, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a term of five years in a total estimated amount of \$6,226,312.45. The amount payable pursuant to this master agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the contract for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for veterinary medical supplies and medications for the Department of Dallas Animal Services. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases for veterinary medical supplies and medications for the Department of Dallas Animal Services under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$6,226,312.45, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term to Midwest Veterinary Supply, Inc., MWI Veterinary Supply, Co. dba MWI Animal Health, IDEXX Distribution, Inc., and Merck Animal Health from Master Agreement Contract No. POM-2019-00010245.

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SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
