WHEREAS, on February 11, 2015, City Council authorized a five-year service contract, with three one-year renewal options, for waste collection and disposal services for City facilities with Moore Disposal Corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$2,359,325, by Resolution No. 15-0266; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2019, Moore gave notice that Moore Disposal Corporation had entered into an asset purchase agreement with Premier Waste Services, LLC and Louis Sabia for the purchase of the business names Moore Disposal and Moore Waste and Recycling, vehicles, equipment, customers, permits, inventory, tangible personal property, unearned accounts receivable, telephone numbers, Department of Transportation numbers, and other books and records of Moore Disposal, Inc. which closed on May 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2019 the City Council consented to the transfer of the assets of Moore Disposal to Premier Waste Services, LLC dba Moore Waste Disposal, and Premier Waste Services, LLC dba Moore Waste Disposal is now the franchisee under Ordinance No. 26659.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to (1) consent to the assignment of the service contract with Moore Disposal Corporation to Premier Waste Services, LLC dba Moore Disposal; and (2) exercise the first of three, one-year renewal options, to the service contract with Premier Waste Services, LLC dba Moore Waste Disposal for waste collection and disposal services at City facilities for the Department of Sanitation Services, approved as to form by the City Attorney, in an amount not to exceed \$520,000.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$520,000 (subject to annual appropriations) to Premier Waste Services, LLC dba Moore Disposal from Service Contract No. POM-2020-00011821.

SECTION 3. That is resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
