**WHEREAS**, the bid submitted by American Process Group, Inc., 1201 Pacific Avenue, Suite 600, Tacoma, WA 98402, in the amount of \$20,227,240.00, is the lowest and best of all bids received.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the bid submitted by American Process Group, Inc., in the amount of \$20,227,240.00, for doing the work covered by the plans, specifications, and contract documents, Contract No. 19-113, be accepted.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with American Process Group, Inc., approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the two residual collection lagoons owned and operated by the Bachman Water Treatment Plant, in an amount not to exceed \$20,227,240.00.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$20,227,240.00 to American Process Group, Inc. from the Water Construction Fund, Fund 0102, Department DWU, Unit CW30, Object 3110, Program 719113, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-DWU-2019-00011352, Vendor VS100522.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
