ORDINANCE NO. 31414

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 20860, "Thoroughfare Plan - City of Dallas, Texas,"; changing the dimensional classifications of Merit Drive between Park Central Drive and IH-635 from a four-lane undivided roadway (S-4-U) in 60 feet of right-of-way to a special four-lane divided roadway (SPCL 4D) in 80 feet of right-of-way; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 20860, "Thoroughfare Plan - City of Dallas, Texas," is amended by changing the dimensional classifications of Merit Drive between Park Central Drive and IH-635 from a four-lane undivided roadway (S-4-U) in 60 feet of right-of-way to a special four-lane divided roadway (SPCL 4D) in 80 feet of right-of-way to read as shown on the attached Exhibit A.


SECTION 2. That Ordinance No. 20860 shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so ordained.
