WHEREAS, a lawsuit styled William Paul Taylor v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-19-06871, was filed by the plaintiff, William Paul Taylor, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile/pedestrian collision on June 21, 2018, involving a Dallas Water Utilities vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff has agreed to a proposed settlement of the case whereby the City will pay William Paul Taylor, the J. Alex. Law Firm, P.C, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$28,500.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed settlement of the lawsuit, styled William Paul Taylor v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-19-06871, in an amount not to exceed \$28,500.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay William Paul Taylor and the J. Alex. Law Firm, P.C., and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the amount of \$28,500.00 from Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
