

**WHEREAS**, on December 11, 2019, City Council authorized the acquisition, upon the necessity of acquiring real property and authorizing its purchase for public use of improved land containing approximately 31,144 square feet, for public use in conjunction with the Lake Tawakoni 144-inch Transmission Pipeline Project by Resolution No. 19-1888; and

**WHEREAS**, Sydnie L. Wallace will be displaced as a direct result of this property acquisition and will vacate the property; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 39A of the Dallas Code of the City of Dallas provides moving expense and replacement housing payments for individuals displaced by City of Dallas property acquisition activities.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That Sydnie L. Wallace will be displaced in conjunction with the construction of Lake Tawakoni 144-inch Transmission Pipeline Project and is entitled to moving expense and replacement housing payments pursuant to Chapter 39A of the Dallas code of the City of Dallas.

**SECTION 2.** That Sydnie L. Wallace is eligible to receive a moving expense payment in an amount up to \$2,650.00 and a replacement housing payment in an amount up to \$54,253.00.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants in favor of Sydnie L. Wallace, in an amount not to exceed \$56,903.00 for moving expense and last resort calculated replacement housing payments.

These warrants are to be paid as follows:
