WHEREAS, the City of Dallas is the recipient of a Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDs (HOPWA) Competitive Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), to provide permanent supportive housing for persons on parole living with HIV/AIDS, for the period October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) was signed into law on March 27, 2020, and included additional HUD funds to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus, of which \$10 million in HOPWA Grant Funds were set aside for HOPWA competitive grantees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to use its allocation of these HOPWA competitive grant funds totaling \$83,282.00, to supplement HOPWA formula grant funds and provide additional short-term rent, mortgage, and utility assistance for persons living with HIV, in accordance with the Program Statement approved by City Council on April 22, 2020, by Resolution No. 20-0645.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDs (HOPWA) Competitive Grant (Grant No. TX-H2001W024, CFDA No. 14.241) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), in the amount of \$83,282.00, to provide short-term rent, mortgage, and utility assistance and supportive services for persons living with HIV/AIDS, for the period May 1, 2020 through April 30, 2023; and execute any and all agreements and other documents required by the grant, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$83,282.00 in the COVID-19 HOPWA Competitive Grant Fund, Fund FC04, Department MGT, Unit 998C, according to the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds as reimbursement from HUD in an amount not to exceed \$83,282.00 in the COVID-19 Competitive Grant Fund, Fund FC04, Department MGT, Unit 998C, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$83,282.00 from the COVID-19 HOPWA Competitive Grant Fund, Fund FC04, Department MGT, Unit 998C, according to the attached Schedule A.

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SECTION 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to HUD any expenditures identified as ineligible. That the City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement. Further, the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final HUD audit reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to make changes to the grant in accordance with HUD regulations and to provide additional information, make adjustments, and take other actions relating to these budgets as may be necessary in order to satisfy HUD requirements.

SECTION 7. That this grant agreement is designated as Contract No. OCC-2020-00013695.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
