**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Keystone Turbine Services (VC18128) through an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Fort Worth, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for helicopter turbine engine overhauls, rebuilds, repairs, and associated rentals for helicopters for the Police Department for a term of three years, in the estimated amount of \$1,959,068.00. The amount payable pursuant to this cooperative purchasing agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the contract for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$1,959,068.00, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term to Keystone Turbine Services from Service Price Agreement Contract No. DPD-2020-00014777.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas and it is accordingly so resolved.
