The meeting of the Ethics Advisory Commission was called to order at 12:15 p.m. on January 9, 2002 in room 4CN #1. Commissioner Tarpley moved to approve the minutes of the October 26, 2001 meeting, November 30, 2001 Declaratory Hearing of Brenda Reyes, and December 6, 2001 preliminary panel hearing of Carol Brandon as distributed by the City Secretary's Office. Amendments were made to the draft cover letter and unanimously approved. Chairman Perez reminded the commission members that they have the right to submit a minority report to the council.

Discussion was held regarding scheduling of future meetings. Commissioners expressed their desire to move forward with the cases pending before the commission. The commission rescheduled the declaratory hearing of Brenda Reyes for Friday, February 15, at 9 a.m. in room 6ES and the full Ethics Advisory Commission hearing of Carol Brandon for Friday, February 22, at 9 a.m. in room 6ES.

The commission viewed the ethics video for boards and commission members.

Commissioner Clark asked for the list of boards and commissions members that had not filed their financial disclosure reports and the status of members who were currently serving without having filed. The city attorney's office stated that the council would have to take action.
