Meeting called to order at 9:17 AM.

Commissioner Bluiett moved to approve the minutes of the January 21, 2005 meeting as distributed by the City Secretary's Office. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Tarpley and passed unanimously.

The Commission reviewed and approved the sub-committee (comprised of Chairman Daniel Perez, Vice-Chair Calvin Bluiett and Commissioner Jim Clark) report detailing the meeting held on February 11, 2005 with Mark Duebner, Director of Business and Procurement. Chairman Perez gave highlights of the meeting.

Commissioner Gloria Tarpley presented a hand out entitled, "Ethics Advisory Commission Presentation on Code of Ethics in Dallas" for possible use as a promotional tool at Town Hall meetings, etc. It was stated that the hand out could be incorporated into a Power Point presentation, or developed into a brochure and placed in the City Secretary's office for distribution to citizens. Once developed, the hand out would be equipped with a disclaimer composed by the City Attorney's office stating that it was for informational purposes only, not legal advice or a replacement for the Code of Ethics.
